


## **Social Media Image Guide**

## Q: Why are images on social media important?

- Visual content is more than 40x more likely to get shared on social media than other types of content (source: <u>Buffer</u>)
- Facebook posts with images see 2.3x more engagement than those without images (source: BuzzSumo)
- Content with relevant images gets 94% more views than content without relevant images (source: Kissmetrics Blog)


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## Q: I don't have an image in our photo library to match my post. What do I do?

There are terrific photo apps and desktop programs available that allow you to use stock photos and make them your own or upload one of your own images and add text overlays. One app we use frequently at ds-connex is <u>WordSwag</u> (available only for iOS in the App Store).


Sample of stock photos in WordSwag:
